142,350 STRONG

Members of all ages engaged in health, wellness, and social connectedness programs. Including 25,675 senior citizens. 3,285 volunteers and 3,917 donors support the work of our YMCAs in 12 associations and their branches.

12,410 HOUSING NIGHTS

Operating Courtney Place Veterans Housing in Salem. Mid-Willamette Family YMCA Veterans Housing in East Albany coming in 2026.



1,160 RESPONDERS

471 trained as lifeguards and 689 trained in First Aid and CPR. Over 300 youth ages 14-24 were certified and hired as lifeguards and swim instructors with the 2023-25 Youth Development Oregon Future Ready Grants.



10,090 KIDS

Learning essential swim skills, drowning prevention, and water safety through swim lessons, swim teams, and Water Safety Days.
